Did you know?

Participation in the Opioid Addiction Treatment teleECHO clinic provides the 16 hours of training required for PAs and NPs to qualify for the buprenorphine waiver FREE OF CHARGE!

(on top of 8 hours of the standard required buprenorphine training from ASAM, AAAP, etc)

The Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act (CARA) extends prescribing of buprenorphine privileges to qualifying Nurse Practitioners (NPs) and Physician Assistants (PAs), but requires them to participate in 24 total hours of approved training. Hours spent in the Opioid Addiction Treatment ECHO qualify for up to 16 hours of the required 24 hours!

Opioid ECHO provides training in opioid addiction treatment using simple videoconferencing technology at no cost, delivered right to your clinic, with a variety of bi-weekly schedules to choose from; sessions include addiction treatment training, including management of naloxone/buprenorphine (e.g. Suboxone) and injectable naltrexone (e.g. Vivitrol).
